

Juliette Trek Challenge

What: The Juliette Trek Challenge is a patch designed for Juliette Girl Scouts to earn through an engaging challenge. Juliette Girl Scouts, with the help and support of their Juliette Mentor, can work on the patch throughout the Girl Scout membership year. The trek helps provide guidance as a Juliette Girl Scout customizes her Girl Scout experience and is a great place to start if you are a new Juliette Girl Scout and perfect for returning Juliette Girl Scouts as they continue their Girl Scout journey.

When: Earn the Juliette Trek Challenge patch during the Girl Scout membership year. A membership year starts 10/1 and ends 9/30 of the following year.

How: To earn the Juliette Trek Challenge, complete point valued activities and once 100 points have been accrued, submit the check off sheet to purchase the Juliette Trek Challenge patch. You can also use Juliette Funds to purchase the patch. Patches are \$3 plus \$1 S&H. The current challenge ends 9/30/2024, please submit your check off sheet by 10/15/2024 to purchase your patch.
