Victoria S., Bozeman, MT – Collaborated with a child psychologist and a Bozeman School district teacher to learn about child development and learning to implement an art based unit for 2nd graders that followed common core standards for academics. She addressed the decrease of arts in schools to demonstrate that academic learning can be achieved through the arts.

Jessilyn M., Cheyenne, WY – Worked with the Cheyenne Cemeteries to repair damaged headstones, replaced the annual flowers in the flower beds with perennials and trees and repaired the poles supporting the irrigation system. She also collaborated with the Cheyenne Historic Preservation Board to learn more history about the vault building so she can install an informational plaque.

Tabitha C., Buffalo, WY – Partnered with First United Methodist Church where her Girl Scout troop met to design and install new landscaping, stepping stones, bench and prayer box for the congregation and community to enjoy.
