
Juliette Facebook Group

- <u>Get registered</u> for the Juliette Fall Program Kick Off Tuesday September 13th at 6 pm. Spend time with our Product Manager learning what's new this year, get important information for Juliettes as well a chance to have your questions answered. Please note that the kick offs for troops is not applicable to Juliettes and may cause confusion if you attend.
- Complete the Juliette 2022 Fall Product Program Permission Form.
- Review the Juliette Caregiver Letter and Juliette Fall Program FAQs attached to this email and in your mailed packet. Keep them handy throughout the Fall Program and they can also be found at www.gsmw.org/juliettesfallprogram.
- If your Juliette is a Cadette, Senior or Ambassador and would like to earn an additional 2% in Fall Program proceeds instead of receiving the rewards, please email <u>customercare@gsmw.org</u> before October 1st so we can set that up in M2OS.

Juliette Gordon Low is the founder of Girl Scouts and the namesake for Daisy Girl Scouts and Juliettes. In every edition I will give you tidbits about her and her life so you and your Juliette can learn more about her.

Juliette Gordon Low loved to travel and she travelled between the UK and America during World War I. During her stays in the UK she would be a supporter of Girl Scouts and Girl Guides in addition to supporting Belgian refugees in the

UK and raising funds for British soldiers and their families. While in the US she would have girls involved in rolling bandages, planting gardens and canning the produce as well as selling war bonds. Travel opportunities continue to be an important part of Girl Scouts today and Destinations are available to Girl Scouts aged 11-18. Check out the upcoming <u>Destinations</u> and start saving your Juliette Funds as they can be used to offset the cost of a Destination.

Jonnina, a Juliette in Cheyenne, WY earned her Girl Scout Gold Award by partnering with her school district to establish a closet of clothes that school nurses can use for student needs. She surveyed the nurses to find out the clothing types most needed, established a space in a central location within the school district for storage and engaged the community by raising awareness for the need for donations. Jonnina inventoried the 2000 clothing items she received and established a request and delivery process for the school nurses. So the closet will always be stocked, she ensured that her high school will keep the community engaged by holding an annual clothing drive. Congratulations Jonnina on a job well done!



Dakota is a Juliette in Bozeman, MT and for many years she has supported veterans in her community through the Montana State University Veteran Center. This year she received hundreds of Gift of Caring packages and donated to the center as well as to the Montana State University Campus Cops and the T2T Ukraine Children's Fund. In addition to these in person donations she mailed cookies to the Montana Deployed National Guard and a veteran in Buffalo, WY who hosts community veteran gatherings.
