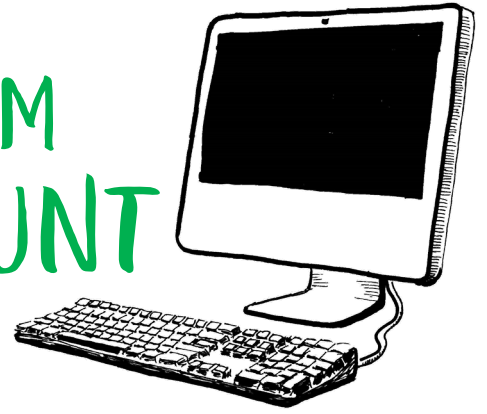

Click on each web cam listed below and look for the living sea life.

Aviary Cam -

How many birds do you see?

Is there anything else living there?

Coral Reef Cam -

How many colors of fish can you see?

Can you see fish that have good camouflage?

Jelly Cam -

What color are the sea nettles?

Which direction are they swimming?

Kelp Forest Cam-

Find at least 3 colors of fish

What does kelp do?

Monterey Bay Cam

What if anything is sitting on the rocks?

What is the weather like outside?

Shark Cam-

Can you tell which one is a leopard shark?

Moon Jelly Cam-

What color are the moon jellies?

Which direction are they swimming in?

Open Sea Cam -

Do you see a manta ray?

Do you see a giant sea turtle?

Sea Otter Cam-

How many sea otters can you see swimming?

Are they doing anything else today?

Penguin Cam-

What are they doing right now?

Look closely at their webbed feet, what are these be good for?
