Don't Forget Signed Receipts

Receipts, receipts, receipts!
Girl receipts are to be retained by the troop for one year and are only submitted to Council in the event of an Outstanding Balance Form submission.

Please be sure to print two copies of any product receipts

to have one copy for each party. Both copies must be signed.

If you don't have a printer, no problem! Email customercare@ gsmw.org with your Service Unit/troop number and where to send the receipts no later than November 1st.


