For over a century, Girl Scouts of Montana and Wyoming (GSMW) has empowered girls through leadership, community involvement, outdoor experiences, entrepreneurship, and STEM learning. To expand accessibility and better serve girls across our region, we are excited to partner with local schools and after-school programs to bring Girl Scouts directly to girls during the 2026–27 school year and beyond.

Introducing Girl Scout Squads

Girl Scout Squads are troops that are formed within our partnered schools and after-school program sites. During the 2026-27 school year GSMW will be establishing one Daisy (K-1st) and one Brownie (2nd-3rd) Squad in each partnering site.

Girl Scout Squads meet twice a month after school, learning valuable life skills, while earning badges and patches along the way. Establishing troops in schools and after-school programs creates a strong sense of safety and familiarity for girls, not only in environment but in leadership as well. Girl Scout Squads are typically led by an existing staff member of the site, who GSMW issues a stipend to for going above and beyond their daily commitments.

The Impact of Site-Based Programming



Nationwide, 8,000+ new Girl Scouts have joined through school-based troops



Nationally, school-based programming has a sustainability rate of 79-84%



80+ new girls can join a Girl Scout Squad every year through GSMW



To continually expand our reach and promote accessibility, GSMW plans to partner with two new sites each year!



80% of Girl Scouts have a strong sense of self, 75% report positive values, and 57% engage in community problem solving!

Community Leadership and Sustainability
